Important Information About Accidental Damage Coverage (ADC)

- ADC is available to all families with students enrolled in RSU #20 schools and assigned an RSU #20 device. ADC only covers devices owned by the RSU.
- ADC must be paid in full by October 15th, or within two weeks of new student enrollment if during the school year.
- ADC cannot be purchased after damage has occurred.
- ADC covers damage due to either accidents or negligence, whether it happens in an RSU building or in another location.
- ADC does NOT cover intentional or deliberate damage.
- Device warranty repairs are covered by RSU 20.
- If you are unable to pay the cost(s) during these difficult times, maybe we can help. Please contact your child's school.

How does ADC work?

At the start of the school year, you pay a fee for coverage (see below). If you have purchased this coverage and the device is damaged, you will pay a deductible of \$25. If the cost of repair is less than your deductible, you will pay the lower amount. If the device is damaged a second time, the deductible is \$100.

How does the "Family Cap" work?

For multiple students in a household, the Family Cap kicks in at \$80. This means that a family pays a maximum of \$80 to cover all students in the same household. For example, if a family had a 3rd grader, a 7th grader and a 9th grader, they would only pay \$80 instead of \$90. All forms should be turned in clipped together, with a single payment (cash or a single check made payable to RSU #20).

How and by whom will repair costs be determined?

An RSU #20 IT Department technician will evaluate the damage based on best practices and guidance from vendors if needed. If the repairs can be done here in RSU #20, we will make repairs. If the repairs require returning the laptop, tablet, hotspot to the vendor, then RSU #20 will do so.
