As we fast approach the start of another school year, there are some changes and points of clarification that require your attention concerning RSU #20's food service program.

Breakfast and lunch free for all students through December 31, 2020

The summer feeding program has been approved through the end of 2020. This means all students PreK-12 will receive breakfast and lunch FREE of charge.

Cafeteria Hygiene Protocols

For students who are in-person, breakfast and lunch will be served while maintaining a cafeteria capacity of no more than 50 students present unmasked at 6ft spacing. Microwaves will be removed from the cafeteria as they cannot be disinfected in between uses. Lunches brought to school by students must be ready to eat and not require additional heating. A-la carte and salad bar items have been removed and replaced with prepared meals and selections to limit handling by students. All trays and eating utensils will be single use and disposable.

Meal Pick Up

When students are on a remote day, meals will still be available. The sign up for meals, available on the RSU #20 website, must happen by Friday of each week to pick up meals for the next week. However, between September 8th and September 18th there will be flexibility on ordering deadlines. Beginning Friday, September 18th, meals must be ordered ahead. Meals must be picked up on the day that the meals are ordered for at the middle school/high school between **10:00 and 10:40 at the back Church Street entrance nearest the high school gymnasium.**
